## Midwest Talent Search

We are pleased to announce that 14 of our seventh and eighth graders scored 95% or better in specific areas of last spring's achievement tests that allows them to be eligible for the Northwestern University Midwest Academic Talent Search. This means they are eligible to take the ACT and SAT tests that juniors in high school take. We are proud of these young people and their academic abilities that God has blessed them with.

## IMPORTANT: Immunizations

The State of Michigan has adopted new requirements concerning childhood immunizations. We are required to submit the immunization records of all kindergarten and sixth grade students as well as students in other grades who are new to our school. **Two** doses of varicella (chicken pox) vaccine are now required, rather than the one dose previously required. Additionally, for students ages 7 – 18 (including 6<sup>th</sup> graders), tetanus/diphtheria vaccine must be given if the last dose was received more than five years ago. Students from 11 – 18 must also receive 1 dose of meningococcal vaccine. If you received a letter from the school office, please be sure to check with your doctor or the Saginaw County Health Department about bringing your child up to date. This report is due at the end of October and students may be excluded from classes if they are not current with their immunizations. If your child is in fifth grade, you will want to make sure to check with your doctor during your next visit. THANK YOU.
